What is the author's purpose for the following story?

A candy maker in Indiana wanted to make a candy that would be a witness, so he made the Christmas Candy Cane. He incorporated several symbols for the birth, ministry, and death of Jesus Christ. He began with a stick of pure white, hard candy: white to symbolize the Virgin Birth and the sinless nature of Jesus, and hard to symbolize the Solid Rock, the Foundation of the Church and firmness of the promises of God.

The candy maker made the candy in the form of a "J" to represent the precious name of Jesus, who came to earth as our Savior. It could also represent the staff of the Good Shepherd with which He reaches down into the ditches of the world to lift out the fallen lambs who like all sheep have gone astray. Thinking that the candy was somewhat plain, the candy maker stained it with red stripes. He used three small stripes for the blood shed by Christ on the cross. So that we could have the promise of eternal life.

Unfortunately, the candy became known as the Candy Cane. It became a meaningless decoration seen at Christmas time. But meaning is still there for all those who "Have eyes to see and ears to hear." We pray that this symbol will again be used to witness to the wonder of Jesus and His great love that came down at Christmas.

Snow is one of the six main types of precipitation. Snow is what we call the small ice crystals that fall when the weather is very cold. Snowfall is made up of both single ice crystals and clumps of ice crystals. The clumps are called snowflakes. It snows when water vapor in the atmosphere freezes into ice crystals. Snow is clear, but it appears white with the way light reflects off ice crystals.

There are different types of snow. There can be a dusting of light snow or a heavy snowstorm that could be very dangerous. Snow can cause dangerous driving conditions. During a heavy snowfall visibility is reduced and can create icy conditions on the road.

How Does Cold affect the Body?

Temperature can really affect how our bodies work. If the temperature is too cold frostbite can occur. Frostbite is a condition that usually affects the fingers, toes, ears, and nose. The skin and underlying tissue freezes and blood vessels contract. Blood flow and oxygen is reduced to the affected areas. Frostbite can be very damaging to the body.

Hypothermia is another condition our bodies can suffer in cold weather. Hypothermia takes place when a person's body loses heat at a rate quicker than it can produce it and their body temperature drops extremely low. Low body temperature can harm the body in many ways.

Cold weather can affect our bodies in other ways that may not be as life threatening. Cold air is very dry. The cold dry wind can dry out our skin and leave us with red cheeks and cracked lips. It can also make us wheeze and short of breath by irritating the lungs.

Our body has a few defense mechanisms to counteract the cold's affects. One of those is shivering. The quick muscular contractions caused by shivering is the body's way of trying to generate heat and keep our body temperature up. A runny nose is another way our body tries to protect us. The nose increases mucus production to warm up the air before it hits your lungs.





Harp seals spend most of their time in the icy arctic ocean. They hunt fish and crustaceans in the water by diving under. They can stay under water for up to 15 minutes. They have whiskers called vibrissae that help them feel around. Their nostrils are in a closed resting state.

Reindeer are also known as caribou. Reindeer are called caribou in the wild. When they are domesticated, they are called reindeer. Domesticated animals are animals kept as pets or that live on a farm.

Reindeer are mammals and a type of deer. They can run up to 50 miles per hour! Reindeer live on tundra. A tundra is a vast flat, treeless land that stays covered in snow most of the time in the Artic region. They are herd animals and live in large groups together. The migrate, or move place to place, all year. They travel 1,200 miles a year or more.

Reindeer can weigh up to 700 pounds. They are usually between 4 and 5 foot tall not including their tall antlers. Their antlers can be 3 foot tall on their own! Reindeer are the only deer that both the male and female grown antlers.

Reindeer are herbivores meaning the eat plants. They love lichen which is a type of moss that grows on rocks and trees. In the winter they will use their hooves to dig in the snow to look for food.

Reindeer live in herds to help protect against predators. Some of the reindeer's predators are gray wolves, bears, wolverines, and golden eagles.




Polar Bears







A traditional Japanese Christmas food is Christmas cake which is a sponge cake with strawberries and whipped cream. A popular dinner choice is fried chicken.

Businesses and cities decorate for the season with impressive large light displays.

One piece of music is particularly famous around Christmas and the end of year in Japan, and this is Beethoven's Ninth Symphony and its final act the 'Ode to Joy'. In Japan, it is simply known as 'daiku' (meaning number nine.) It is thought to have been sung in Japan at Christmas by German prisoners of WWI, becoming more popular over the years.

CHristmas in Mexico





In the Mexico they say "Feliz Navidad".

In Mexico, Christmas is celebrated from December I2th to January 6th. From December I6th to Christmas Eve, children often perform the 'Posada' processions or Posadas which means inn. For nine nights the children visit the neighbors house and sing a song about Mary and Joseph asking for a room but are sent away until the house where they have a party. On each of the nine nights, a different quality will be focused upon: humility, strength, detachment, charity, trust, justice, purity, joy, and generosity. After the religious service, the hosts distribute food to their guests, often tamales and a hot drink such as ponche or atole. Then the guests break piñatas, and the children are given candy.

Nativity scenes, known as the 'nacimiento', are very popular in Mexico. They are often very large, with the figures being life size.

Christmas Eve is known as 'Noche Buena' and is a family day. People often take part in the final Posada and then in the evening have the main Christmas meal. Popular dishes include Pozole, roast turkey, pork, tamales, and salads.

New Year in Russia





In the Russia they say "S Novym Godom".

In Russia they celebrate New Year more widely than they do Christmas. Christmas is more of a smaller more private celebrate done later in January. New year is when Grandfather Frost visits and brings gifts to the children. He is often accompanied by his granddaughter, Snegurochka. It is traditional to give gifts at midnight to celebrate the new year.

Just before midnight, the Russian President addresses the nation with a short speech in which he reflects on the past year and thanks the people for their support. Right after the speech, everyone counts the chimes of the Kremlin Spasskaya Clock Tower. Then there are fireworks and fun.

Christmas trees were banned in Russia until 1935 when they turned them into New Year Trees.

The Nativity scene or 'pesebre' is an important Christmas decoration and is placed near the Christmas tree.


Christmas dinner is served on Christmas Eve. It could be severed outside as it is warm at Christmas time in Argentina.


There are large light displays and many department stores put on big decoration displays. Only some families put up Christmas trees. The most popular gift to give is money.

At schools and workplaces, a secret gift swap takes place. Gifts are passed through a crack in the door and passed around till they find their owner.

Another fun Christmas time activity is Sternsinger which means star singers. Children dress as Wise men and sing to collect money for charity. They also write a sign over the door with chalk which remains until it fades.

CHristmas in Brazil





In Brazil they say" Feliz Natal".

Brazil has many Christmas traditions. It's quite warm in Brazil at Christmas so many people may go to the beach.


Nativity scenes known as Presépio are popular in Brazil. Christmas plays called Os Pastores, which means The Shepherds, are also very popular. Many people attend Midnight Mass on Christmas Eve. After Midnight Mass there is a firework display.

In Brazil, Santa Claus is called Papai Noel & Bom Velhinho. Children will leave their sock near a window and Papai Noel will exchange the sock for a gift.

Taking part in a 'Secret Santa', known as 'amigo secreto' is popular in Brazil at Christmas. It is traditional to give small gifts all through December using a pretend name. On Christmas Day, people reveal who their amigo secreto was!

CHristmas in Nigeria





One of the many ways to say Merry Christmas in Nigeria is "barka dà Kirsìmatì". There are many other ways to say Merry Christmas in Nigeria because there are many different languages spoken in Nigeria.

Christmas time in Nigeria is a time of great joy and family togetherness. Families in Nigeria will throw Christmas parties that last all night long. Many will journey to visit their older relatives and families leaving the cities a little less crowded. Homes and streets are decorated and often have an artificial Christmas tree. Children will receive money from family and neighbors and use it to buy fireworks. Children also expect a "Christmas cloth" from their parents that they will wear on Christmas day.

Some villages perform masquerades where children wear masks, makeup, and colored raffia and compete with singing and music.

Christmas dinner is served on Christmas. There is a wide variety of food served which included chicken and goat. Other foods are different depending on where in Nigeria you look.

The UK may say Happy Christmas or Merry Christmas.



The UK celebrate Christmas with Nativity Play and carol services. Children write letters to Santa Clause with their Christmas wishes. These letters are placed in the fireplace instead of the mailbox. Santa Clause is also called Father Christmas and leave presents in socking or pillowcases.

Christmas dinner is usually served lunchtime on Christmas day and consists of turkey and many different sides. Dessert is often Christmas Pudding. Mince pies and lots of chocolates are often eaten as well!

Christmas in Jamaica





Because the primary language of Jamaica is English you would say Merry Christmas in Jamaica by simply saying Merry Christmas.

Christmas is special in Jamaica. People paint their houses and hang new curtains. In Jamaica, the Grand Market on Christmas Eve and lasts until morning. People attend in their best clothes and celebrate all night. Everywhere is decorated with lights, known as pepper lights, and street vendors sell food to the attendees.

After the Grand Market people will attend Midnight Mass service or continue the celebrations.

Christmas day begins with a traditional Jamaican breakfast of ackee & saltfish. Families will then attend church. Christmas mass is ajoyful celebration with carol singing and music.

Christmas dinner in Jamaica included chicken, ham, and goat along with sides such pigeon peas and red kidney beans.

CHristmas in Portugal





In Portuguese they say Merry Christmas as 'Feliz Natal'.

The Portuguese love nativity scenes. You'll find them all over Portugal around Christmas, often by the side of the road near roundabouts. Live nativity scenes, where people dress up as characters from the Christmas story, are also incredibly popular and a feature of many towns in Portugal.

Christmas gifts are exchanged on Christmas Eve. Baby Jesus brings gifts and leaves them in shoes set out. Many people go to midnight mass where they will also get in line to kiss baby Jesus.

Christmas dinner, or Consoada, takes place on the eve of the 24th. Portugal's national dish, bacalhau, is probably the most traditional option for Christmas dinner. The traditional Christmas cake is 'Bolo Rei' (which means 'King Cake') and is placed in the center of the table.

CHristmas in Poland





In Polish Happy/Merry Christmas is 'Wesotych Świąt'.

Christmas begins in Poland with Advent to remind people of the reason for Christmas. Advent calendars are popular and are often handmade. The celebrate St Nicholas Day on December 6th. Children hope to receive a small gift from St Nicholas.

Christmas dinner is eaten in the evening and can not begin until the first star is spotted in the sky. Children watch to spot the first star to remind them of the Wise men following the star to Jesus.

There are 12 dishes on the table to represent good luck for the next 12 months as well as the 12 disciples of Jesus. All the dishes are meat free to remember the animals who were with Baby Jesus in the stable. Gifts can not be opened till everyone has finished eating Christmas dinner.

The Christmas tree is bought in and decorated on Christmas Eve. In some houses they break one of the ornaments to scare away evil spirits for the year. Christmas Eve is finished by going to Church for a Midnight Mass service.

To wish someone a happy Hanukkah you would say "Hanukkah Sameach".

Hanukkah is a Jewish holiday that celebrate the dedicating of the second temple in Jerusalem. Hanukkah lasts eight days starting on the 25^{th} day of the Hebrew month Kislev. This day can occur anytime from late November to late December. Jewish people everywhere celebrate Hanukkah not just those in Israel.

Hebrew people eat special foods during this time. The traditional food is fried in olive oil to represent the miracle of the burning oil lamp. They enjoy potato pancakes, doughnuts stuffed with jam, and fritters.


