



Spelling rules

1. We add only "d" to the verbs that end in "e".

Ex:

like	□ liked	I liked the trip.
love	□ loved	He loved eating cheese.

2.If there is one vowel before the last letter, we double the last letter then add (ed).

e.g. tap --- stopped stop ---- stopped

3. When the verbs end in a "consonant +y". cancel (y) and add (ied)

Ex: try ----- tried

We tried a new restaurant.

carry----- carried

They carried their bags to their classes

4. If there is a vowel before the ending (y) we don't cross the (y) but we just add (ed).

e.g. stay stayed

5. Irregular verbs don't follow the rules.

e.g. eat ate

We use the Past Simple to talk about:

Things that started and finished in the past.
 We visited our uncle yesterday.

I lived in London in 2000.

• Things which happened one after the other in the past. *He got dressed, went downstairs and had breakfast yesterday.*
