The present continuous describes what you are doing now. We need to use a be-verb (am, is, are) and add **-ing** to the next verb.

- ▶ I am watching TV.
- ▶ He is sleeping.
- We are dancing.

- ► You are playing computer games.
- ► She is singing.
- They are doing their homework.

We use **not** to make the negative form.

- ► I am not watching TV.
- ► He is not sleeping.
- We are not dancing.
- You are not playing computer games.
- ► She is not singing.
- They are **not** doing their homework.

We use **the past continuous** when we describe a certain period of time in the past. We add **-ing** in order to make the continuous form. The only difference between the present continuous and the past continuous is the be-verb.

Present Continuous	Past Continuous
l am work ing .	I was working.
You are hav ing dinner.	You were having dinner.
She is taki ng a test.	She was taking a test.

We use **not** after the past form of the be-verb to make the negative form of the past continuous.

We use **while** and **when** when we use the past continuous. The part of the sentence that has **while** or **when** is called **the time clause**. The part that has the past continuous form is called **the main clause**.
