Example: a dog, a friend, a student 3. You use 'an' before a noun that starts with a vowel (a, e, i, o, u) Example: an umbrella, an idea, an apple *NOTE: While choosing 'a' or 'an', you should pay attention to how you pronounce the word.

Example: (hour=/avər/) it starts with a vowel so we say 'an hour' (university= / ju:.ni'v3:.si.ti/) it starts with a consonant so we say 'a university'
