

# 12 Tenses

# Present Simple Tense



I eat.

She eats.

Do you eat?

Does she eat?

I don't eat.

She doesn't eat.



# Present Continuous Tense



I am eating.

Are you eating?  
I'm not eating.

She is eating.

Is she eating?  
She isn't eating.

# Present Perfect Tense



I **have** eaten.

She **has** eaten.

**Have** you eaten?

**Has** she eaten?

I haven't eaten.

She hasn't eaten.



# Present Perfect Continuous Tense



I **have** been eating.

**Have** you been eating?

I haven't been eating.

She **has** been eating.

**Has** she been eating?

She hasn't been eating.

# Past Simple Tense



I ate.

She ate.

Did you eat?

Did she eat?

I didn't eat.

She didn't eat.



# Past Continuous Tense



I was eating.

Were you eating?

You weren't eating.

She was eating.

Was she eating?

She wasn't eating.

# Past Perfect Tense



I had eaten.

Had you eaten?

I hadn't eaten.

She had eaten.

Had she eaten?

She hadn't eaten.



# Past Perfect Continuous Tense



I had been eating.

Had you been eating?

I hadn't been eating.

She had been eating.

Had she been eating?

She hadn't been eating.

# Future Simple Tense



I will eat.

Will you eat?

I will not eat.

She will eat.

Will she eat?

She won't eat.



# Future Continuous Tense



I will be eating.

Will you be eating?

I will not be eating.

She will be eating.

Will she be eating?

She won't be eating.

# Future Perfect Tense



I **will** have eaten.      She **will** have eaten.  
**Will** you have eaten?    **Will** she have eaten?  
I will **not** have eaten.    She **won't** have eaten.



# Future Perfect Continuous Tense



I **will** have been eating.      She **will** have been eating.  
**Will** you have been eating?      **Will** she have been eating?  
I **will not** have been eating.      She **won't** have been eating.
