

Meet my family

Level:

This lesson can be used on all ages of beginner to elementary students.

Target:

The aim of this lesson is to improve speaking skills talking about the family and to review grammar revising the possessive adjectives.

Preparation:

First print the activity sheets. Photocopy them for each student in the class.

Activity:

After going through your regular review and teacher talk, tell the students that they're going to review the possessive adjectives and learn new vocabulary about the family.

Go through the activity sheets together.

It's a good restaurant. **Its** phone number is 0543387. Senegal is in Africa. **Its** flag is red, yellow, and green. Look at that fish! **Its** eyes are yellow.

It's = it is It's an Italian restaurant. Its = possessive Its name is Spaghetti House.

Possessive 's

Listen to the mp3n. 4.10

This is Jack's car. Ella is Ben's wife. Maria is Carlos's sister. My sister's name is Molly. This is my parents' house.

We use 's after a person to talk about family and things, e.g. Ann's brother, Jim's car. We use 'after plural people, e.g. my brothers'room (= two brothers). 's

She's American. Her name's Emma. ('s = is) Emma is Maria's daughter. ('s = possessive s) pronunciation of 's 's usually = /s/, e.g. Jack's or /z/, e.g. Maria's. 's after a name that ends in s = /iz/, e.g. Carlos's = /'ka:lDsIz/
