\*The sight word *day* is from Fry's 1<sup>st</sup> 100 words and is included because of its frequency, especially at calendar time/math meeting.

\*I have also included *back* because of its ability to be sounded out and its similarity to *black*. *Name* was included because of its frequency of use (like writing your name on the paper where it says Name: \_\_\_\_\_).

\*The word *no* can be found in Level I of my Sight Word Cards.
