The apple was all he had.

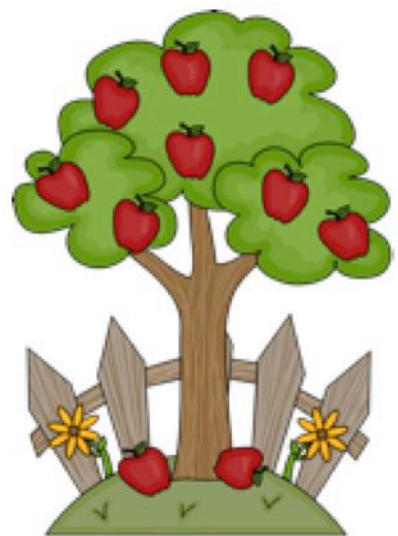
An ant asked Art for a bite.
