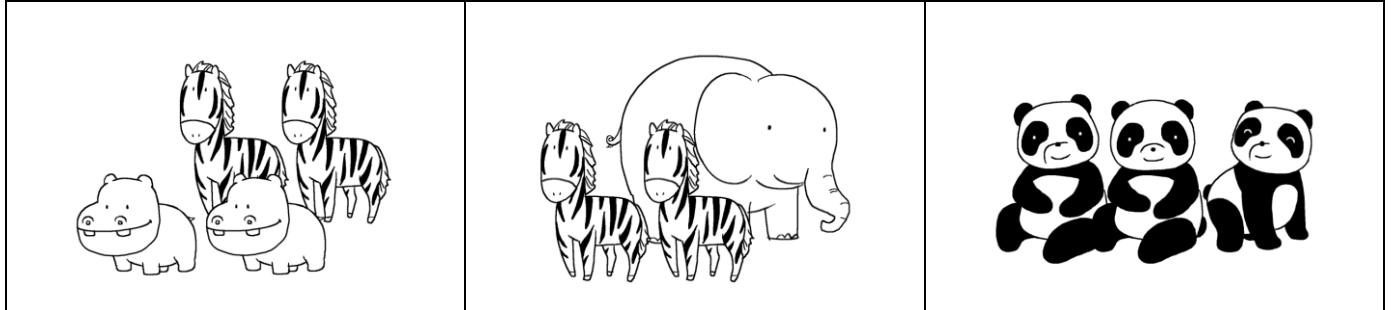


Jeff is writing a poem called 'In the Zoo'. Listen to the poem. Choose the best answer by blackening the circle.

## Audio Script

Jeff is writing a poem called 'In the Zoo'. Listen to the poem. The poem will be played two times. When you hear a beep (*beep*), answer the question. You now have 30 seconds to read the questions. (*30-second music*) Now, listen to the first part of the poem and answer Question 1. The poem will begin now.

① Jeff : In the Zoo

Do you like going to the zoo?

There is lots to see and do.

I can see hippos.

I can see zebras too!

Narrator : Question 1: What can Jeff see? (*beep*) (8-second pause) ①

Now, listen to the second part of the poem and answer Questions 2 and 3.

② Jeff : Look at those birds.

Wow! There are fifteen.

The birds are in the tree.

They are yellow and green.

Narrator : Question 2: How many birds are there? (*beep*) (8-second pause)

Question 3: The birds are \_\_\_\_\_. (*beep*) (8-second pause) ②

Now, listen to the last part of the poem and answer Questions 4 and 5.

③ Jeff : Look at the cute monkeys.

What are they doing?

Are they sleeping or eating?

No! They are singing!

Narrator : Question 4: What are the monkeys doing? (*beep*) (8-second pause)

Question 5: Which pair of words in the poem have the same ending sound?

A. zoo and hippos

B. birds and tree

C. fifteen and green (*beep*) (8-second pause) ③

Listen to the poem again and check your answers. The poem will begin now.

(Repeat [①, ②, ③] without pauses.)
