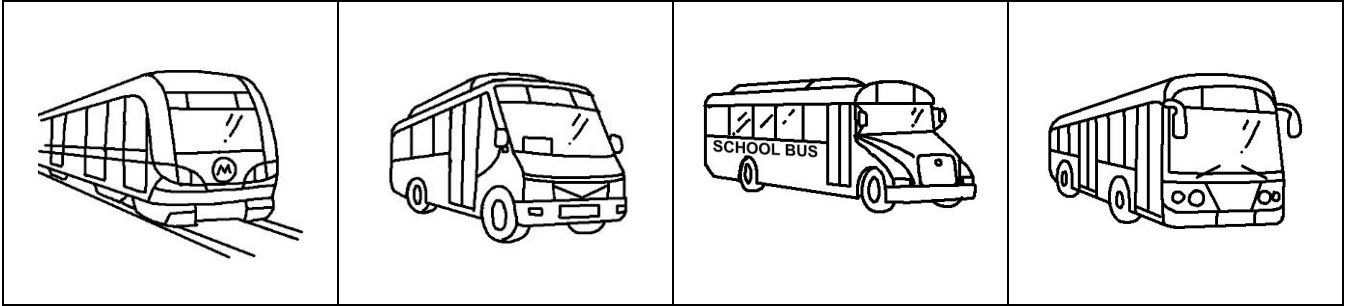

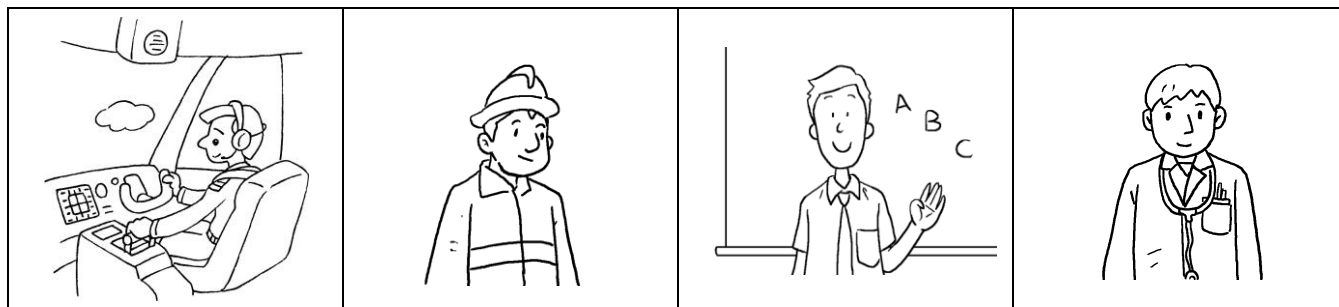

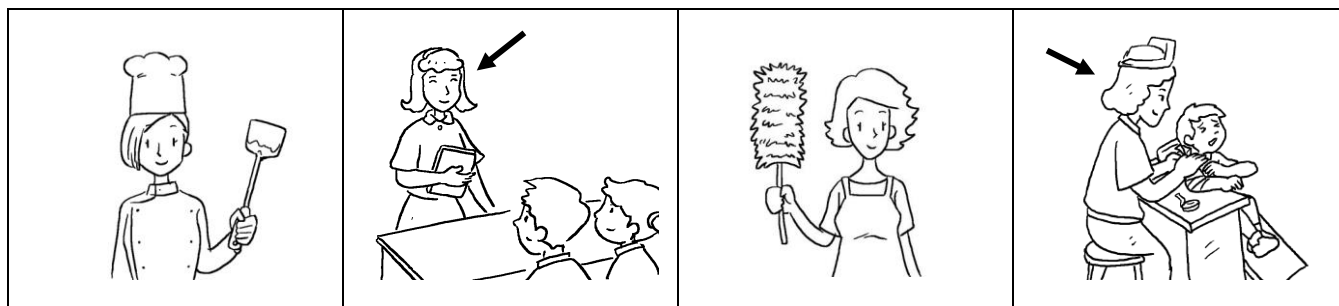

## Audio script

A new teacher Miss Hall wants to find out more about her pupils. She is asking the children some questions. Listen to the conversation. The conversation will be played two times. When you hear a beep (*beep*), answer the question. You now have 20 seconds to look at the questions. (*20-second music*) The conversation will begin now.

- [Miss Hall : Good morning, class! I'm Miss Hall. I live in Baoshan. I come to school by metro. Hello, Ricky. Where do you live and how do you come to school?
- Ricky : I live in Baoshan too, but I come to school by school bus.
- Narrator : Question 1: How does Ricky go to school? (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)
- Miss Hall : How about you, Ella?
- Ella : I live in Pudong. I come to school on foot. My home is near the school.
- Miss Hall : It's good to walk every day, Ella.
- Narrator : Question 2: Where is the school? (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)
- Miss Hall : Now let's talk about our families. I have one brother and one sister. Alan, how many brothers and sisters do you have?
- Alan : I have no brothers or sisters. But I want to have a brother to play with when Mum and Dad are busy.
- Narrator : Question 3: How many brothers and sisters does Alan have? (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)
- Miss Hall : Are they really busy? What does your father do?
- Alan : He's a pilot. He flies planes and goes to many places. He isn't in Shanghai much of the time. He's sometimes out of town for two weeks.
- Narrator : Question 4: What does Alan's father do? (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)  
Question 5: Alan says his father is sometimes out of town for two weeks. What does 'out of town' mean here? (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)
- Miss Hall : What about your mother, Alan? What does she do?
- Alan : She's a housewife. She cooks dinner, does the housework and looks after me. She's sometimes my teacher too. She teaches me English.
- Miss Hall : Oh, you've got the best mum, Alan.
- Narrator : Question 6: Which is Alan's mother? (*beep*) (*8-second pause*)]
- Listen to the conversation again and check your answers. The conversation will begin now.  
(Repeat [ ] without questions and pauses.)
