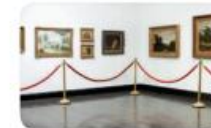

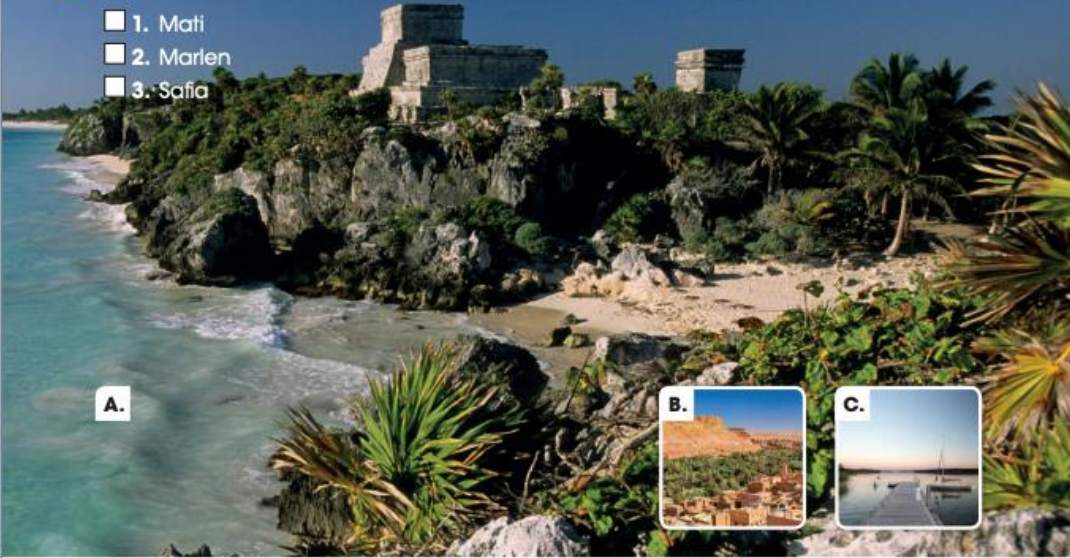

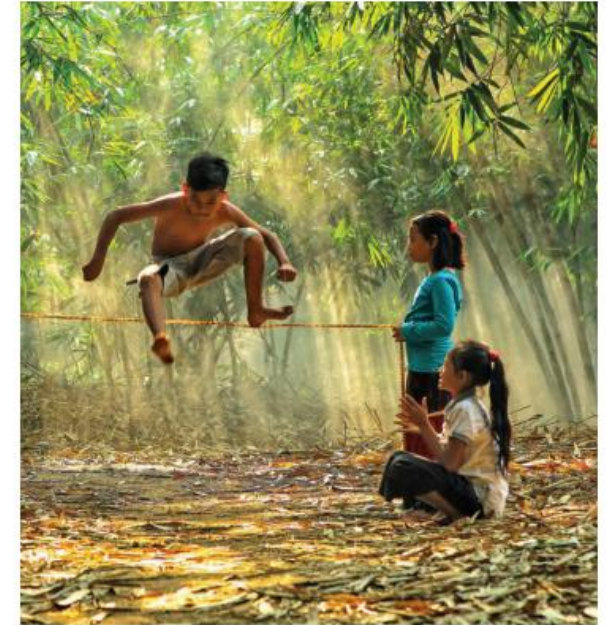

The Comedy Wildlife Photography Awards

Animals are beautiful. But they can be ugly, too. They can be big and scary, or very small. They are always interesting. They can also be funny.

Every year there are many competitions for people who take photos of animals and nature. We all enjoy looking at wildlife, and photos can teach us about animals and our planet. There are competitions for black and white photos, photos of birds, insects, animals at night, animals in the ocean...

But when people see the winning photos, they always love the funny photos. So two photographers, Paul Joynson-Hicks and Tom Sullam, decided to start the first competition for the world's funniest wildlife photos.

In this competition, a team of photographers and comedians choose their favorite photos. The photos must be funny, of course, and make them laugh, but they also have to be very good photos. A lot of the animals in these photos look as if they are smiling, laughing, or making funny faces. Other animals are falling over or photobombing, like in this photo of a bear. There are five winners: the best photo of a land animal, of an animal in the air, of an underwater animal, the best photo by a young photographer, and the best photograph of them all. Thomas Bullivant won the young photographer competition in 2016 with his photo of a zebra, and he was only fifteen years old.

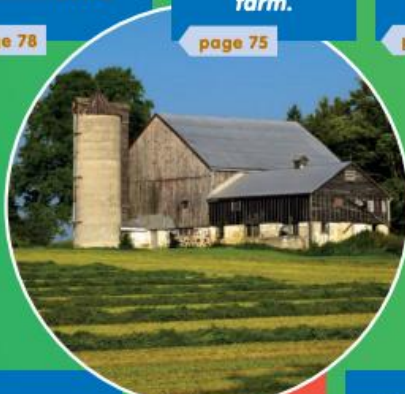
