People drink milk that comes from cows.



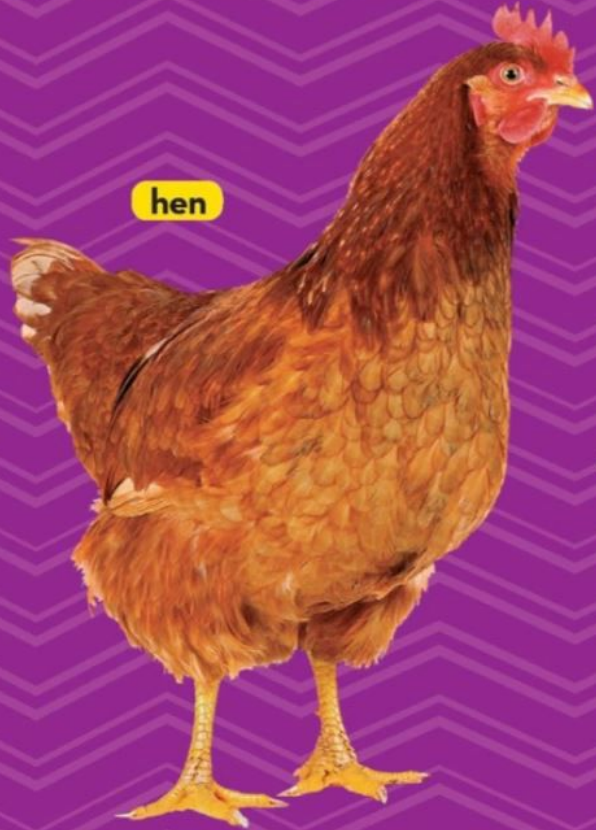
milk comes

People use sheep wool to make sweaters.

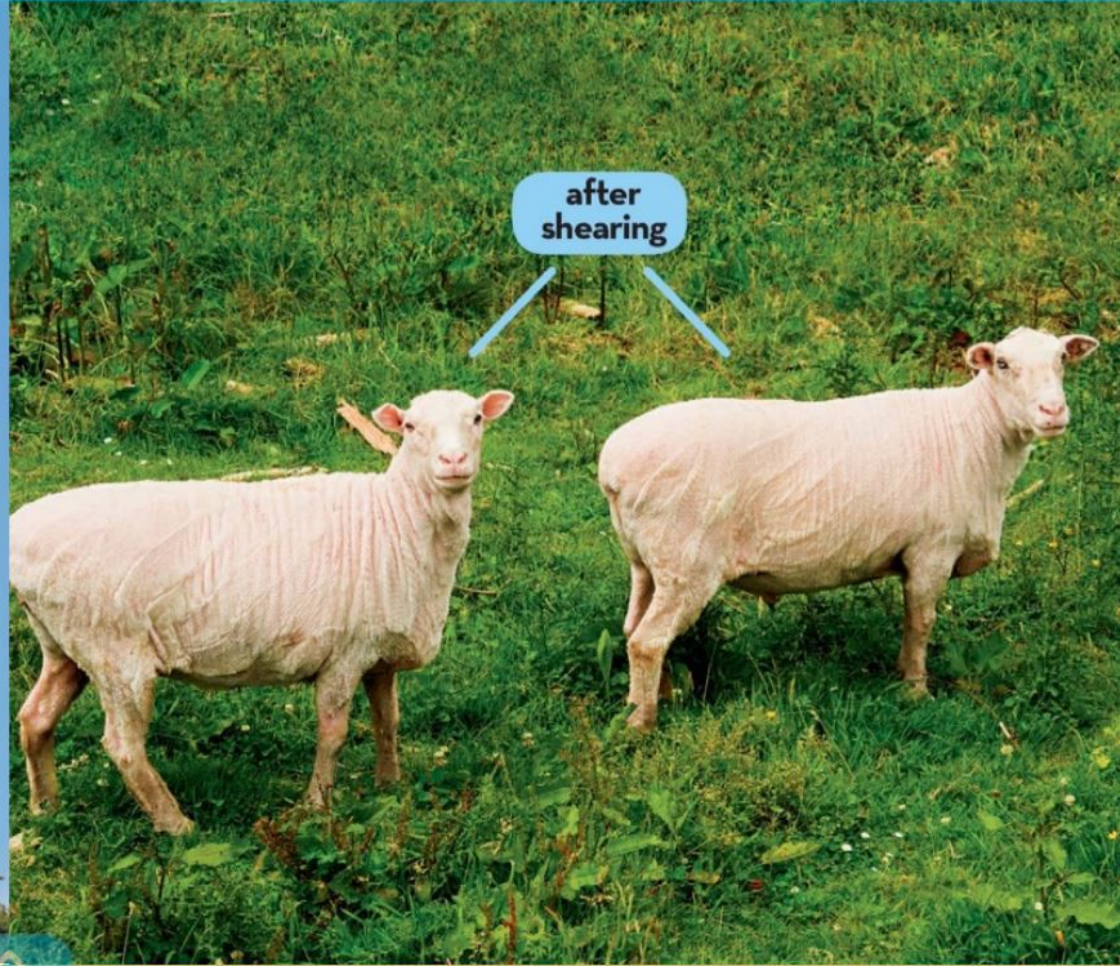
