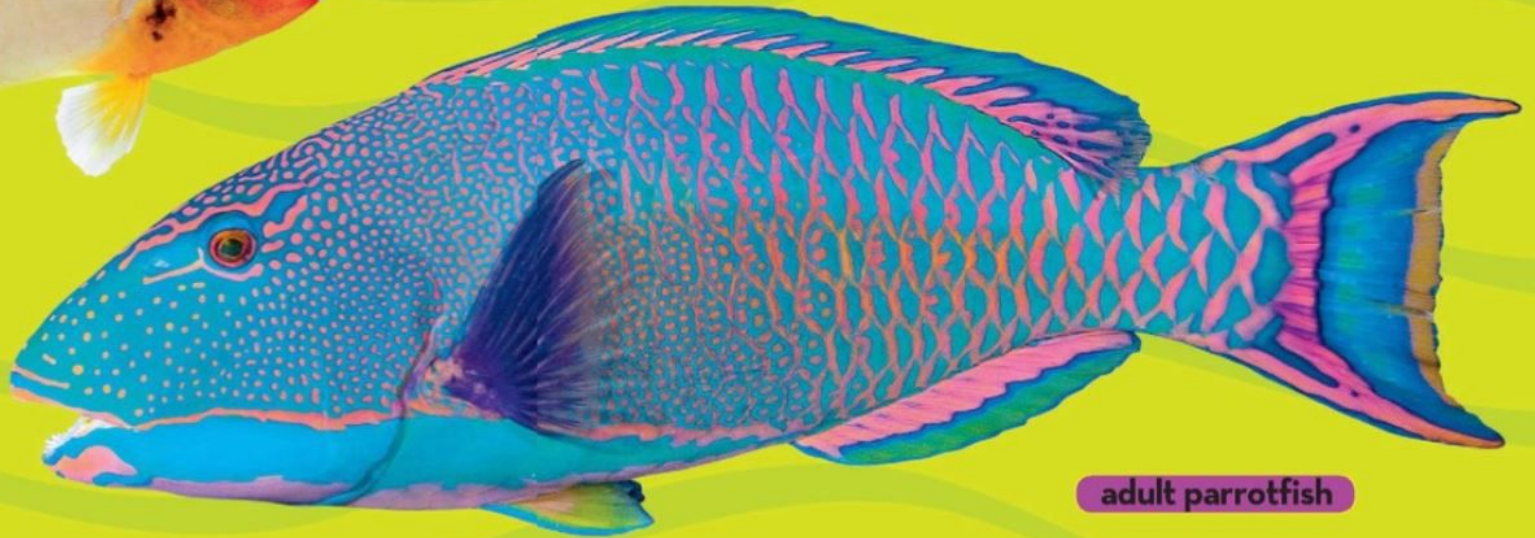


A parrotfish changes color as it grows older.

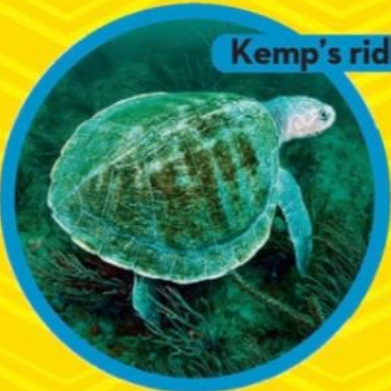

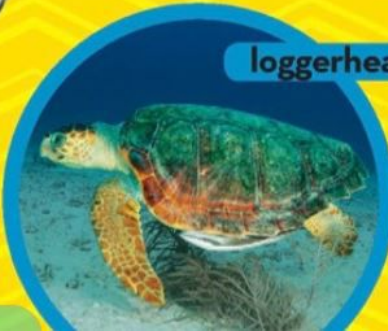
