

Animals Work Together!.....13



Penguins are birds that cannot fly. They walk by moving from side to side.





Penguins can swim!
Wings help them swim.
Webbed feet help them
swim too.



See the penguins dive! They get food in the blue sea.



Penguins eat small fish. They eat krill, or small shrimp, too.



Seals hunt penguins for food.

Penguins live in groups to stay safe from danger. White feathers help penguins hide in the snow. Black feathers help them hide in the sea.



Some penguins live in very cold places. Penguins like to stand in the middle of the group. Why? Because it's warm in there!



Penguins shield each other from the cold.



Penguins make nests with a partner. Some nests are made with stones. Other nests are made of grass. Look at the egg! Will it open? You must wait and see.

This penguin mom feeds her chick.




Now the baby penguins are big! Soon they'll dive into the sea with Momand Dad.




