

Many people enjoy camping. After setting up a tent, they go fishing or hiking. At night, campers fall asleep with the stars above.




After the trip, campers pack up their tents and drive home.



This camel carries a yurt that has been taken apart.









Yurt mats are made from sheep's wool.


In winter, wool mats made the yurts warm. In summer, the mats were taken out.



Next, canvas covers the roof. It helps keep out the rain.


It can take several people to put together some yurts.

Animals, such as camels, do the hard work. They balance the yurts on their backs.



Some people build yurts using kits. A kit does not cost a lot of money.


