

"You go, Fox," said Deer.


"Oh my," said Fox nervously. "There are too many animals watching."

"Hmm, what's tall?" the team wondered aloud.






"That's Mount Sid!" cried Fox. He gulped. "Mean wolves live on Mount Sid. I'm afraid to go up there."

"Because of Fox's memory, we found the posy," said Deer.


"Because of Deer's strong legs, we could climb the mountain," said Bird.


