

What to Do in a Weather Emergency

You should have an emergency kit ready in case. It should have a radio and batteries. It must have food.







The Southwest is different. It is hot and dry. A lot of the land is desert.



Sometimes there is a drought. That means that it does not rain for a long time.






Read about the colors in the sky.
