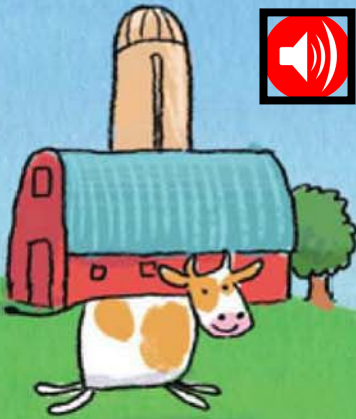


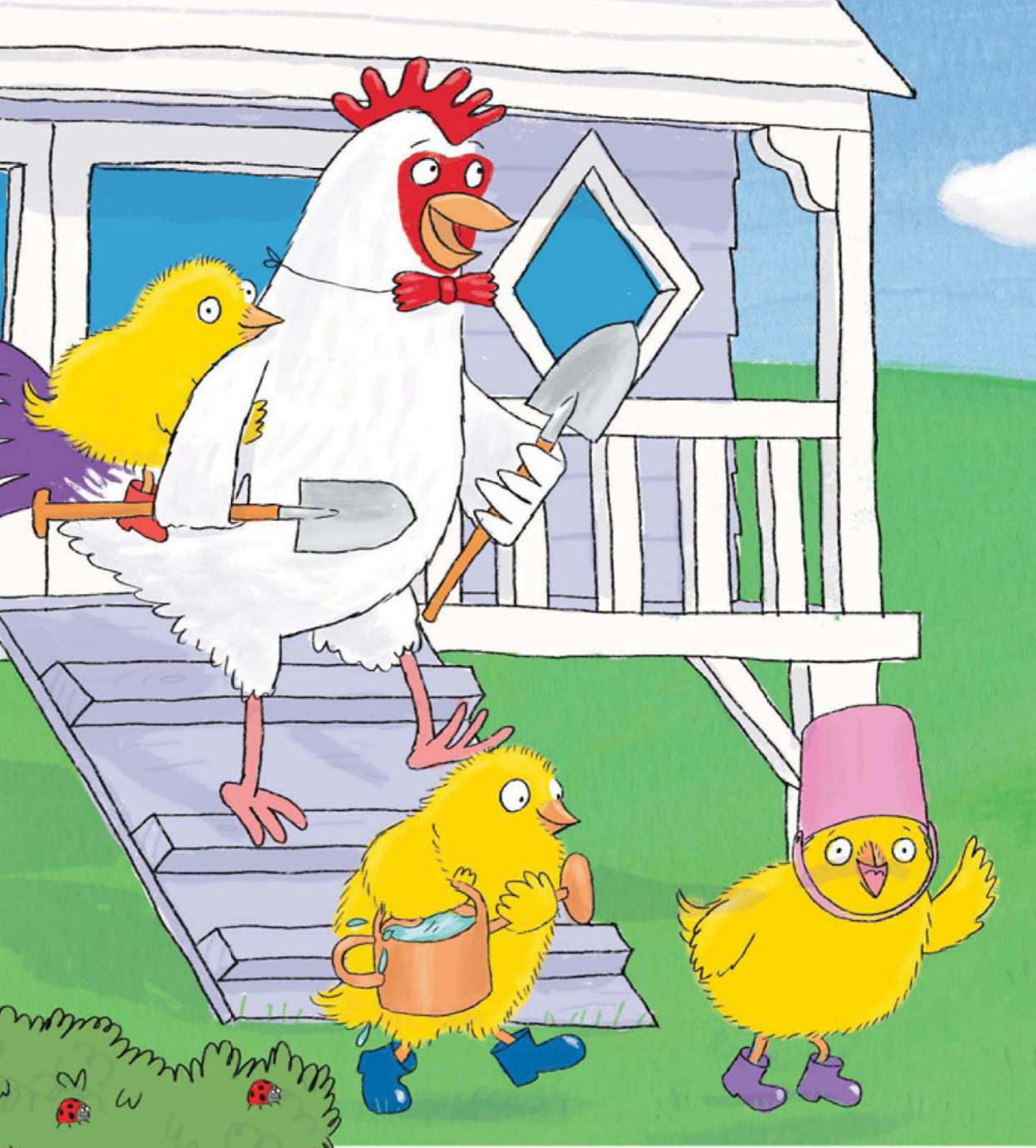

Six kids go **out**.





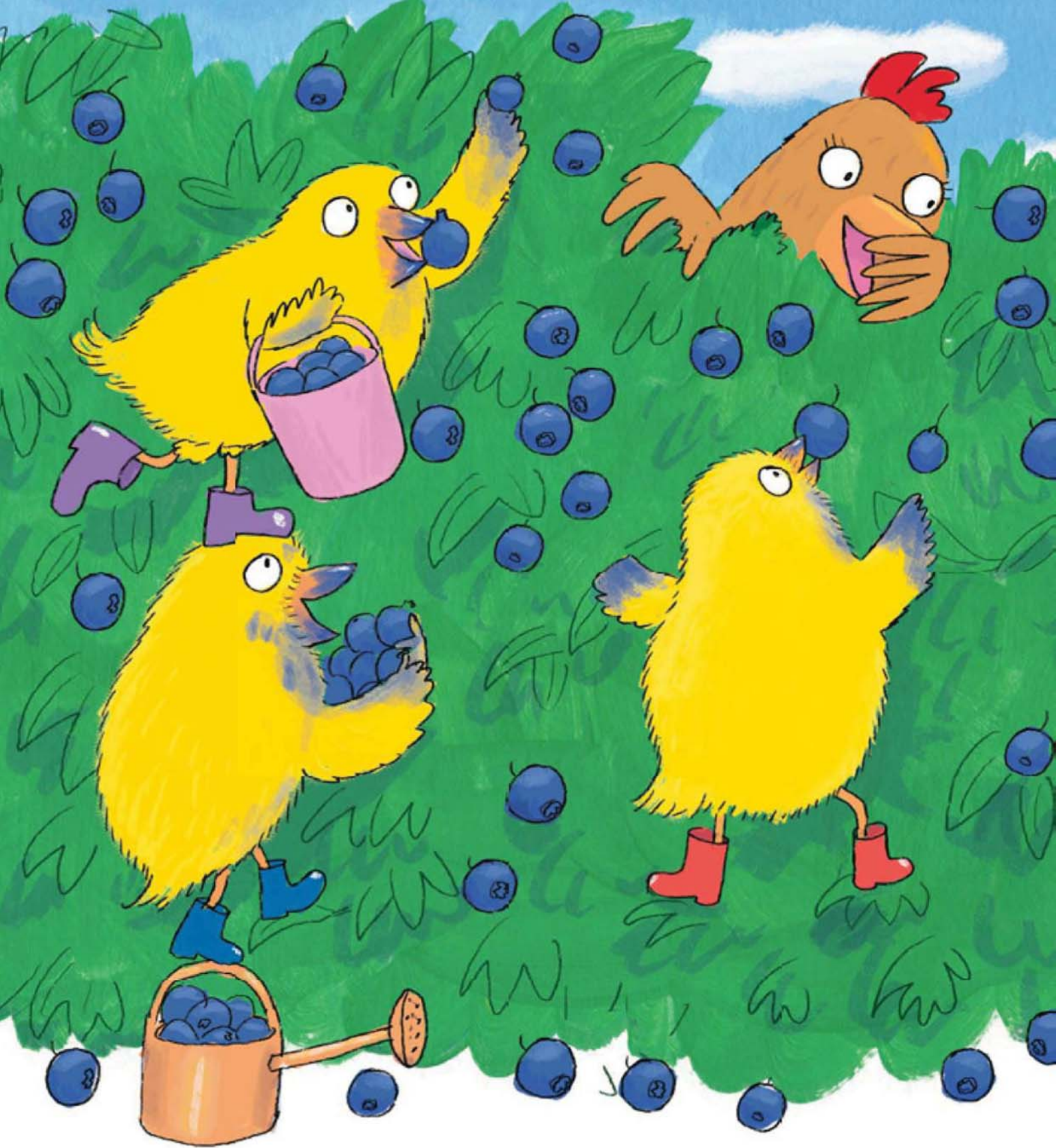
Six kids go **up** a hill.

The sequence is the order in which the key details happen.

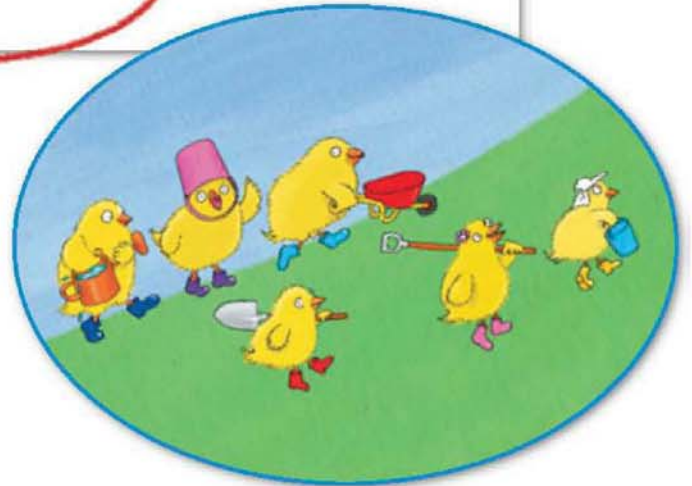


Find Text Evidence

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Six kids go **up** a hill.





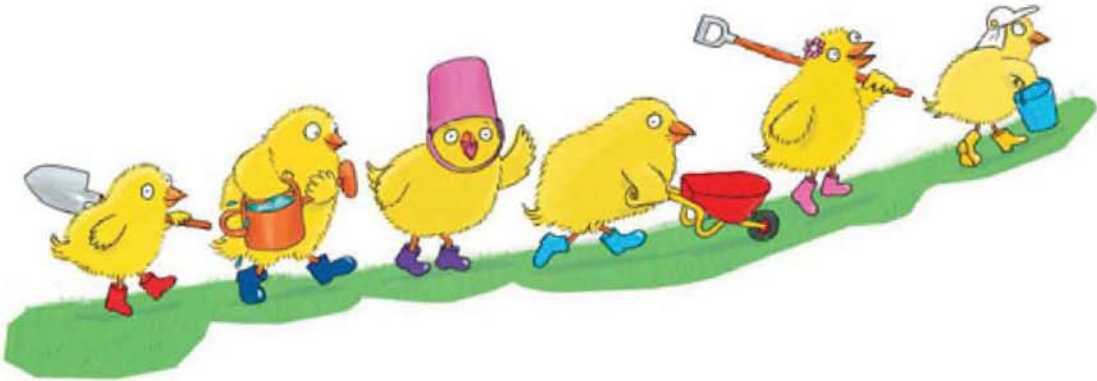
Detail

Then they dig holes to plant seeds in their garden.



Detail
Then the six chicks pick blueberries.

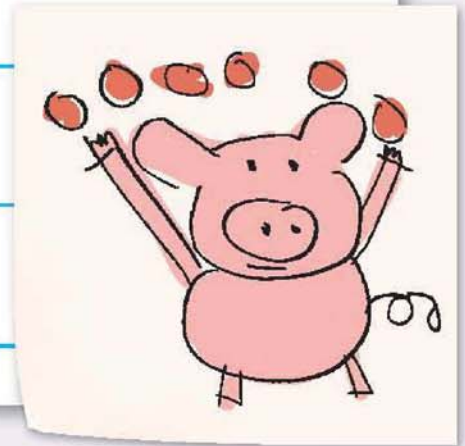


Bill's Story

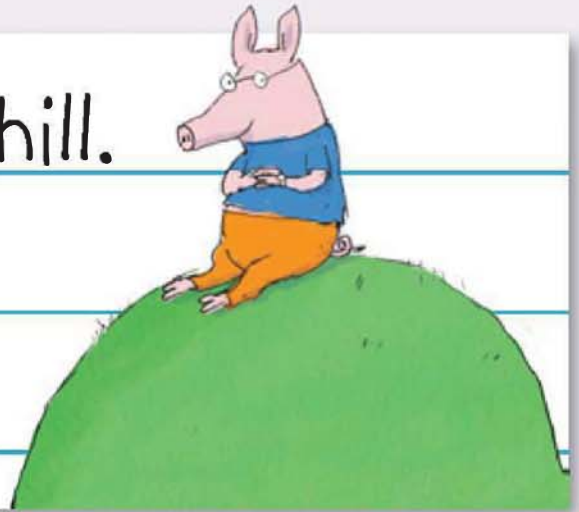
