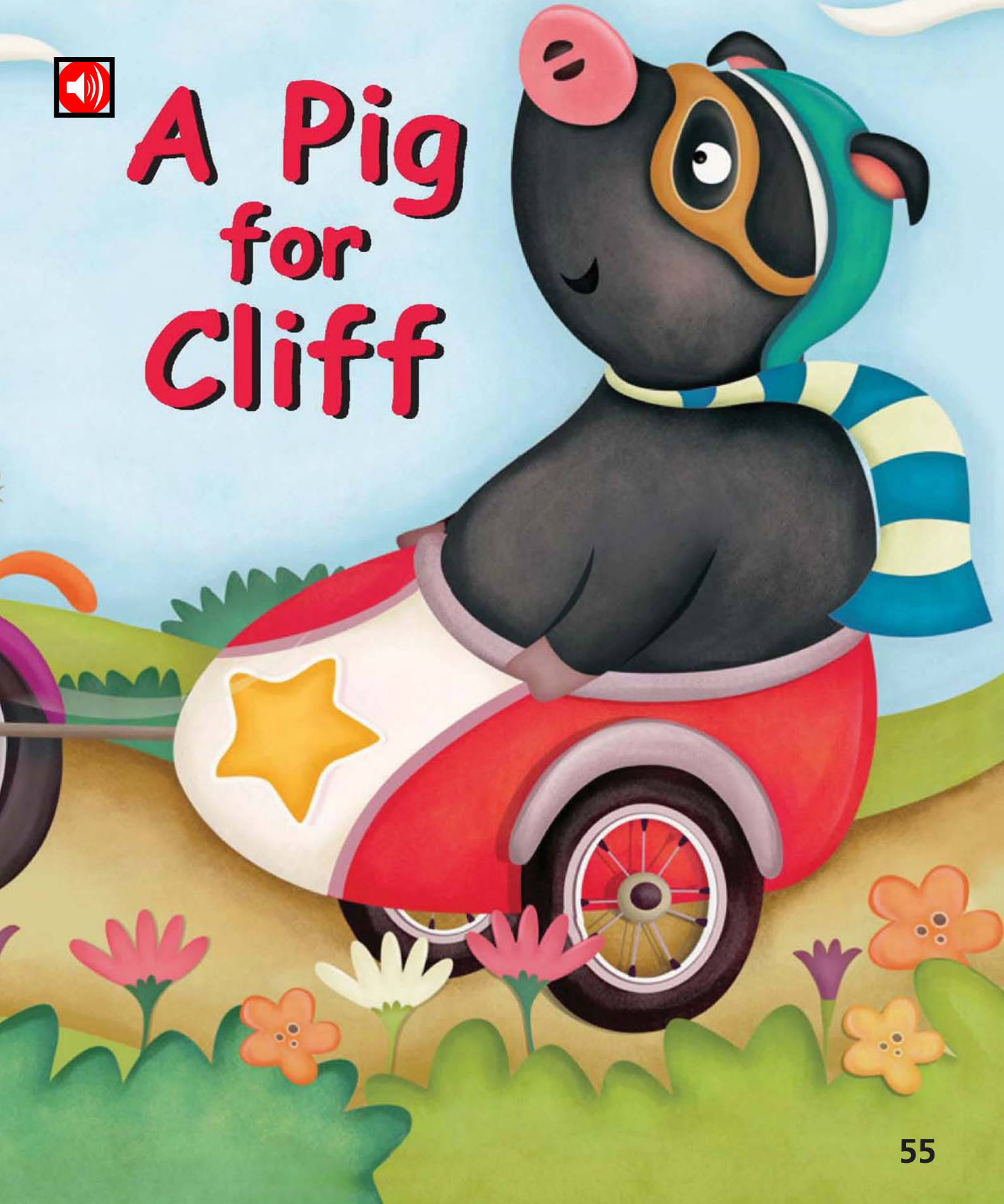

Key details happen in order, or in sequence.



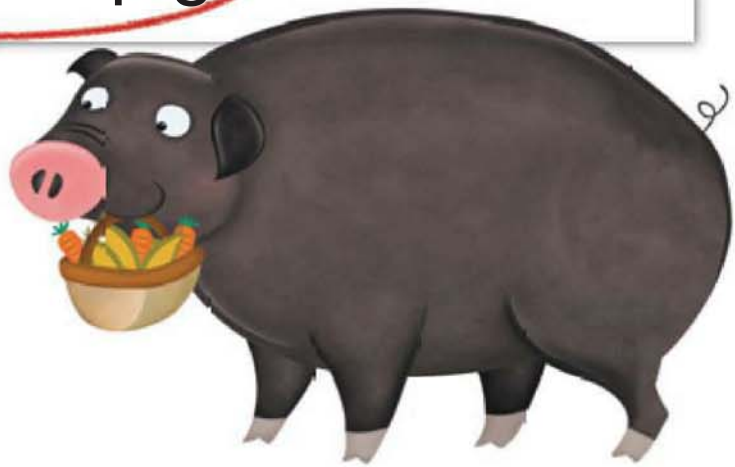
Find Text Evidence

Detail

Detail
Slim pulls Cliff up out of the mud. Slim is a good pet.

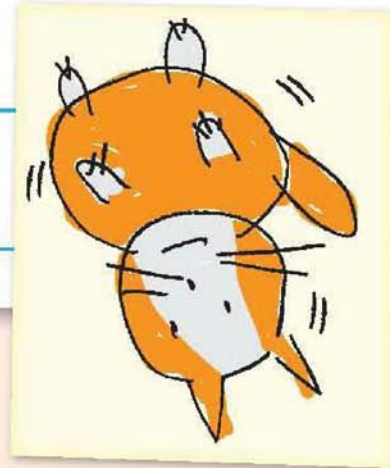
