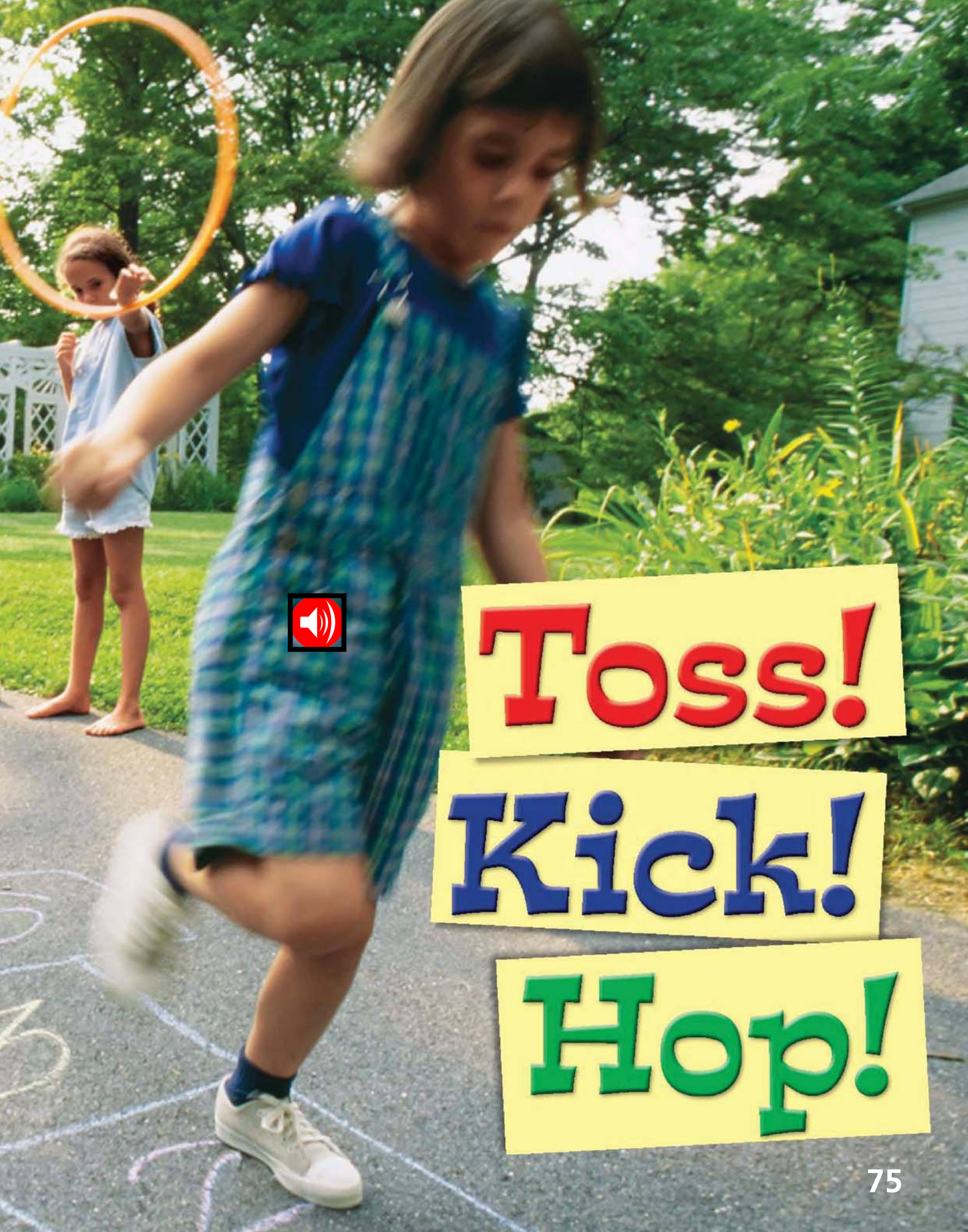

You can use photos to learn key details.



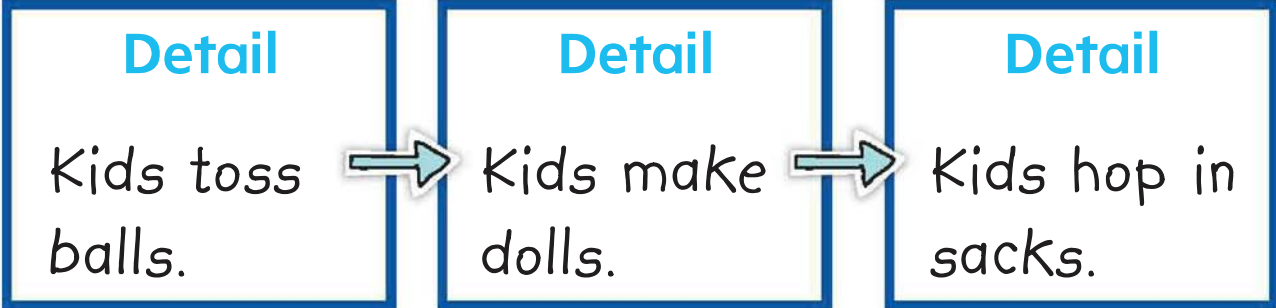

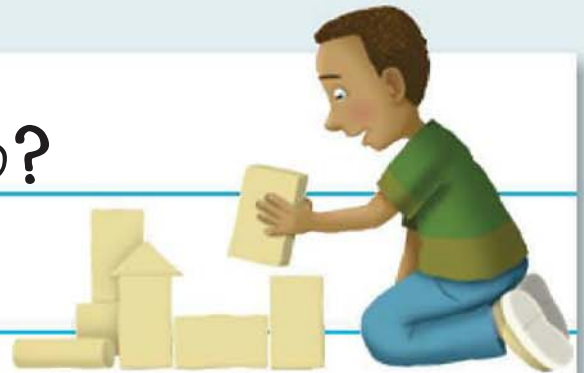
A **question** is a sentence asked to find out something. A question ends with a **question mark**.
