The Ancient Romans lived more than 2,000 years ago in many different countries. Today, we can still see some Roman remains, e.g.

Country	Ancient Roman remains	What were they like?
Spain	mosaics	Pictures and patterns made of small tiles or glass. They were on floors and walls of important villas.
Britain	roads	Long and straight. Made of a lot of big stones with small stones and sand.
Italy	theatres and amphitheatres	Theatre: Semi-circles of seats – thousands of people watched plays and concerts. Amphitheatre: Circles of seats in three parts – people watched lions, tigers, bears and gladiators.
Libya	baths	Very big for all the people in the city. They walked to the baths and washed and played sport there.
