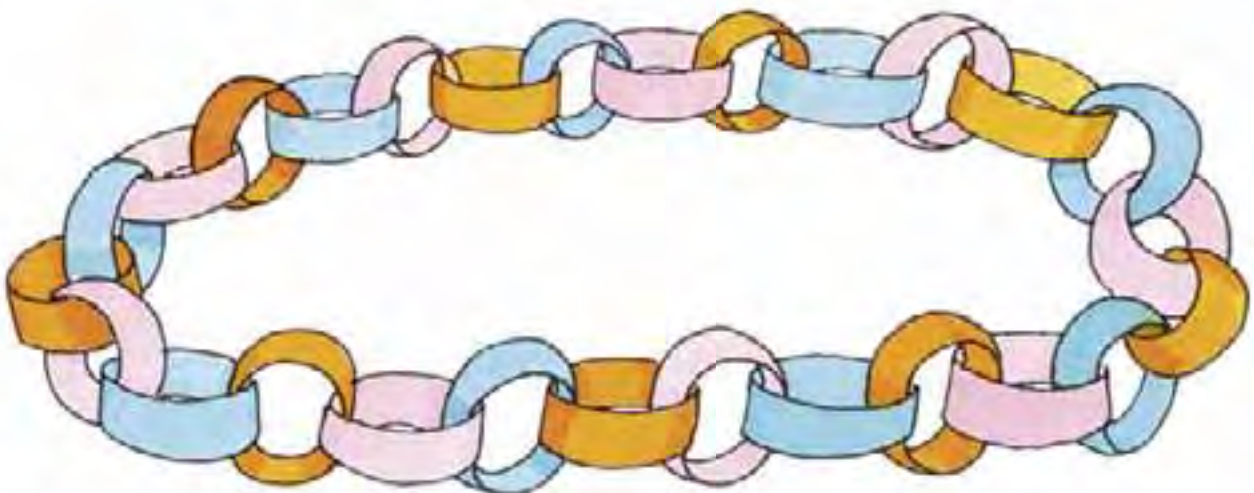
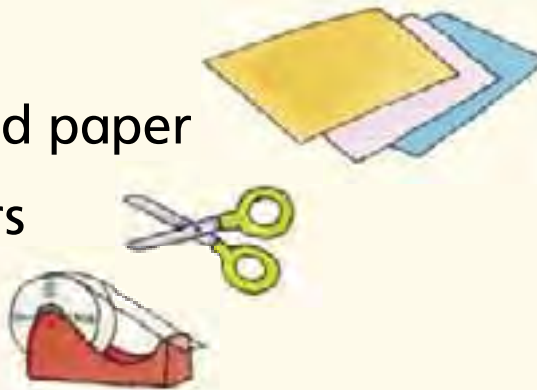

How to Make a Paper Chain

Materials:

- colored paper
- scissors
- tape



Steps:

1 Cut the paper into strips.



2 Take one strip and tape the ends together to make a circle.



3 Take a new strip. Put it through the circle you made.



4 Tape the ends of that strip together.



5 Tape more strips to the chain. Now hang up your chain!
