### **Grammar review - First conditional**

We use the **first conditional** to talk about a possible situation in the future. The structure of the first conditional is:

lf + \_\_\_\_\_<sup>1</sup>, \_\_\_\_\_<sup>2</sup>

If you call me before 1pm, I will answer.

I can come if you invite me.

Remember that we do not use \_\_\_\_\_\_3 after if. We can also use when instead of if.
