We use the **first conditional** to talk about a possible situation in the future. The structure of the first conditional is:

If + _____¹, _____²

If you **call** me before 1pm, I **will answer**.

I **can come** if you **invite** me.

Remember that we do not use _____³ after **if**. We can also use **when** instead of **if**.

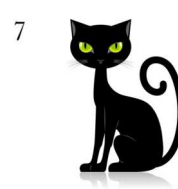
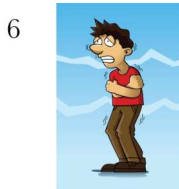
