## About the Game:

Task: the student matches the shape outlines to the corresponding shapes on the train and train station.

### To Assemble the Game:

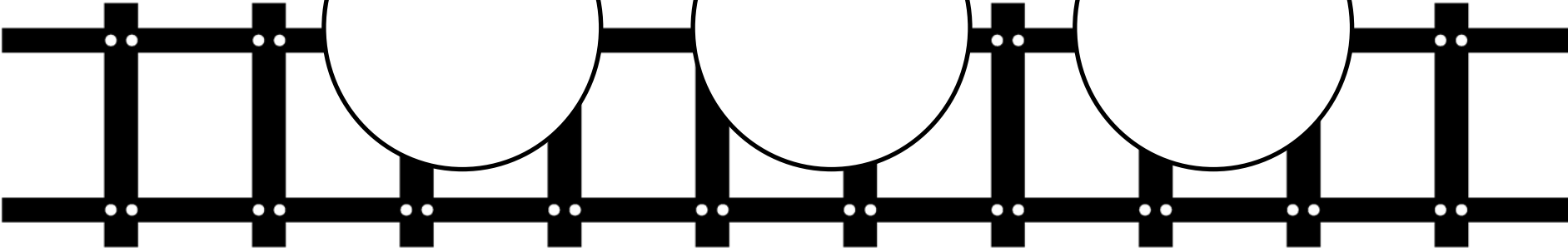
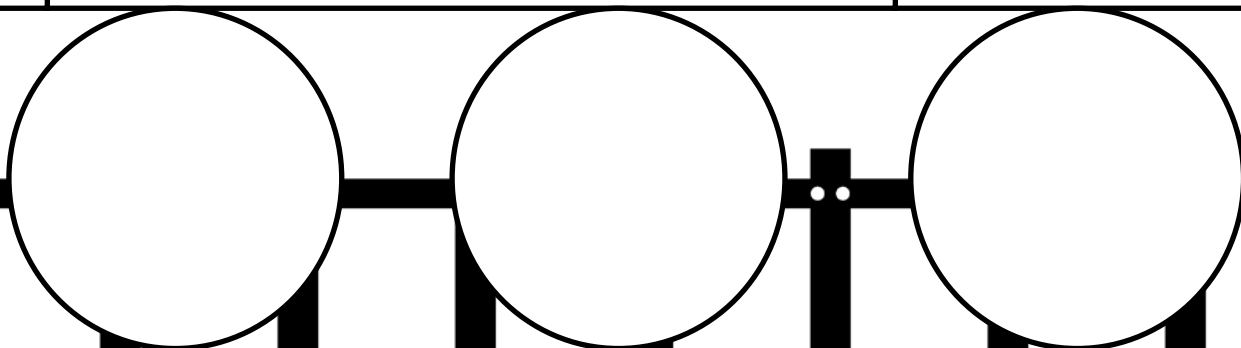
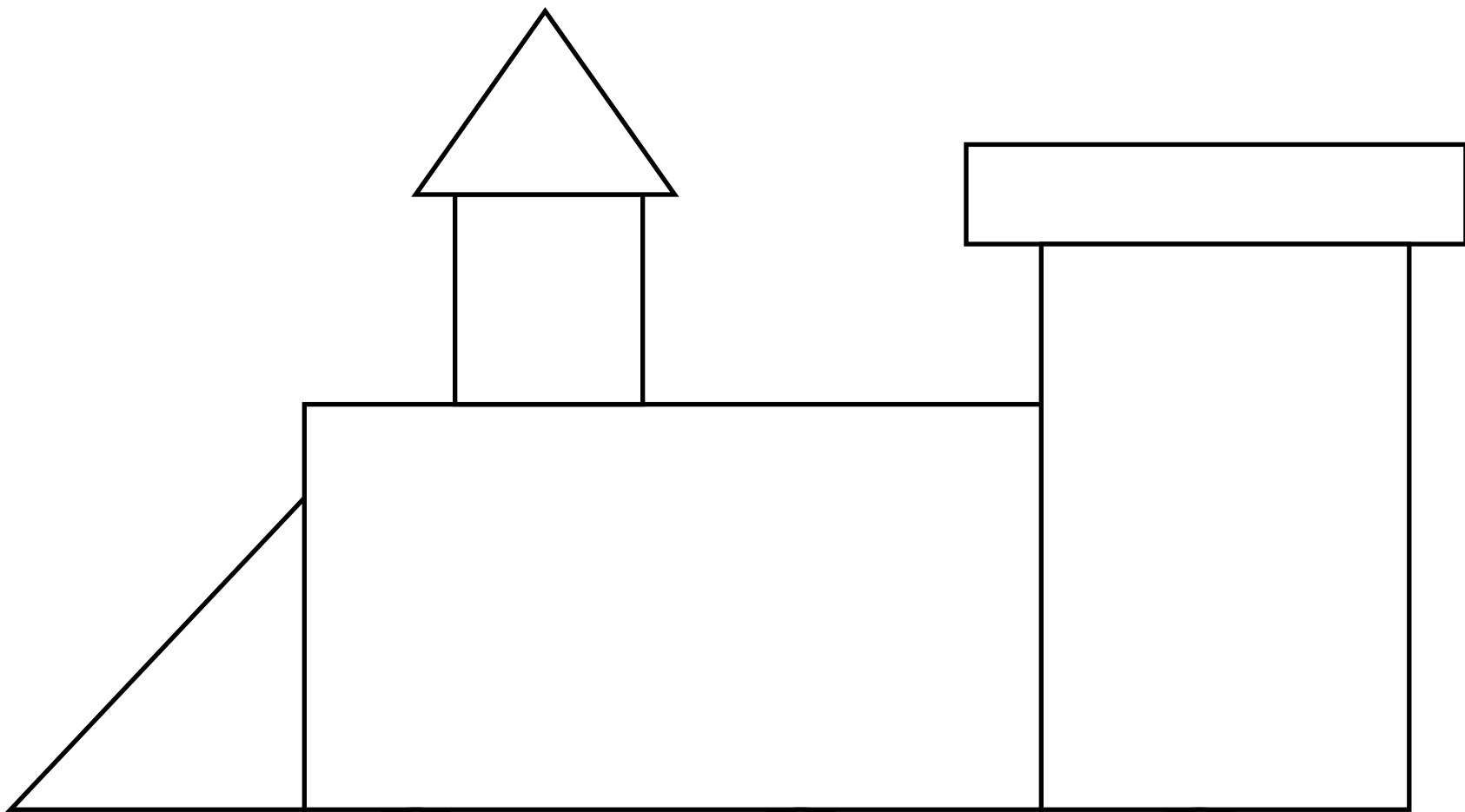
Print the train and train station page, and paste each one on one side of a file folder (you can trim around the edges to make them fit in the folder better if you'd like).

Laminate the folder and the page of shapes.

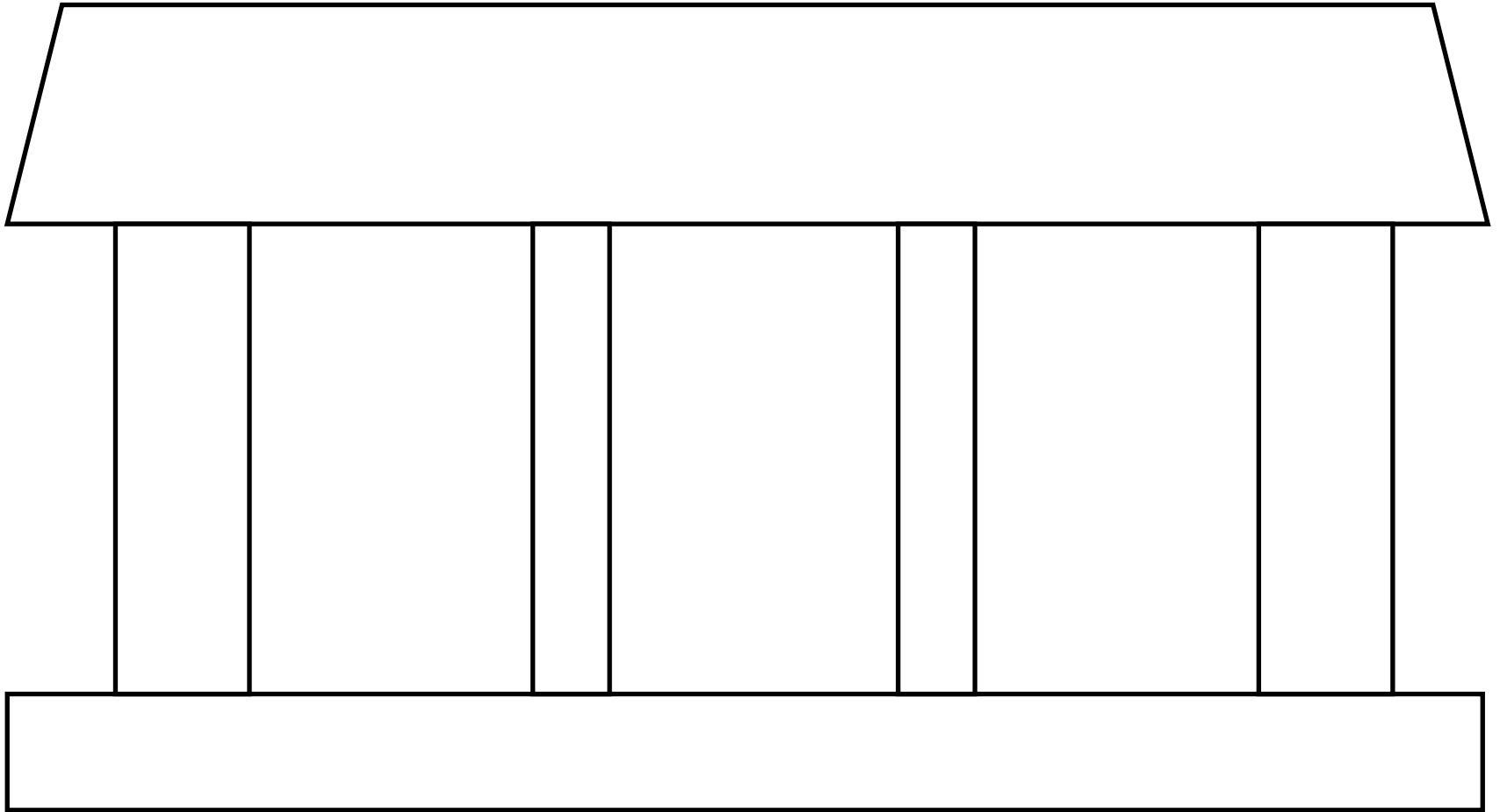
Cut out the shapes after the page of them is laminated.

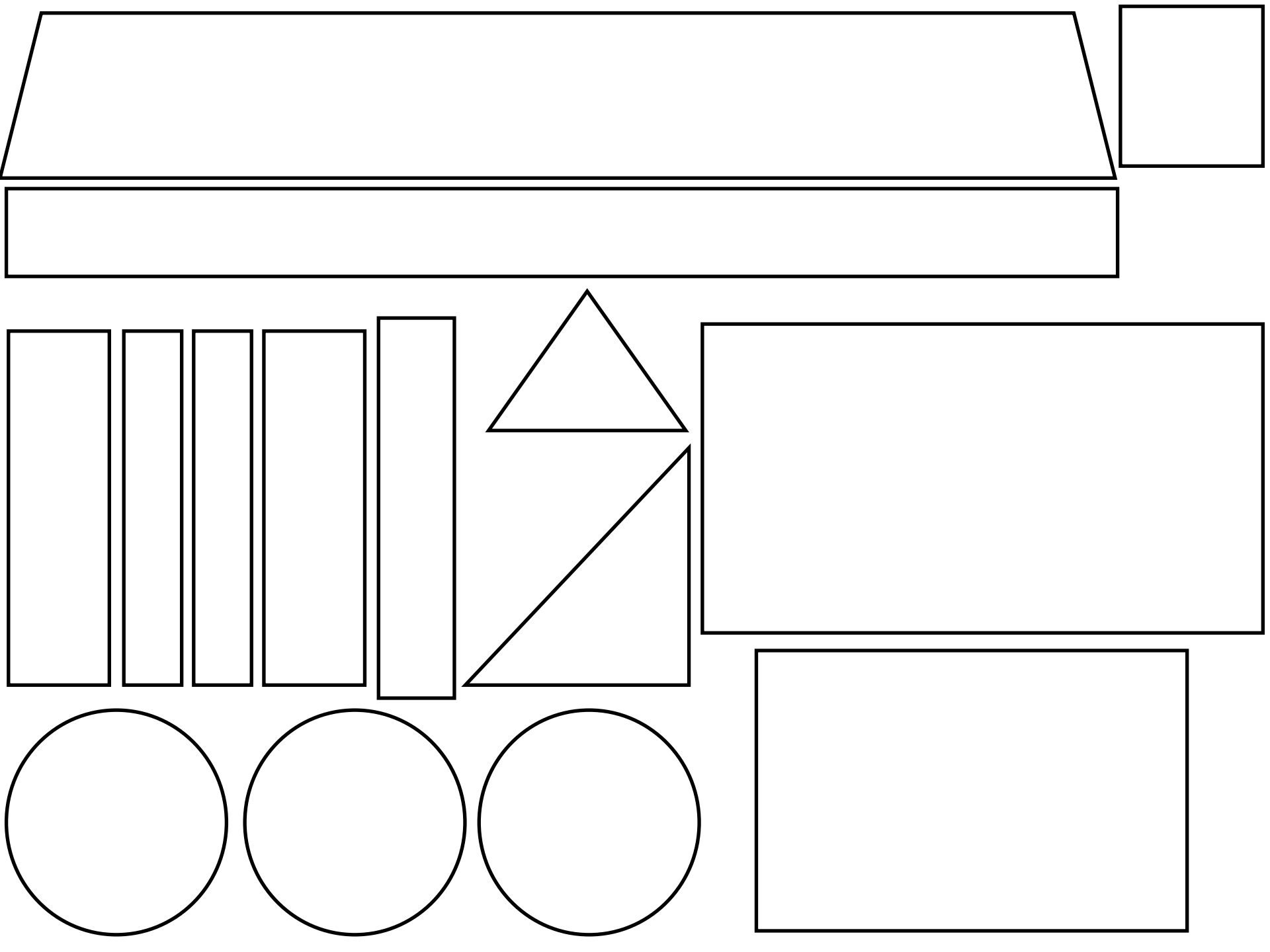
Put Velcro dots on the blank shapes and inside each shape on the train and train station pictures.

The students match the shapes to their corresponding shapes on the pictures by attaching them with the Velcro.
