STEREOTYPES: BEING A GOOD WIFE AND A GOOD HUSBAND

Objective: Improve conversation skills and vocabulary

Materials: Use the sheets and flashcards provided

Procedure

- 1. Introduce yourself and ask the students to introduce themselves to each other.
- 2. Briefly introduce today's topic: being a good wife and a good husband
- 3. Hand out the flashcards to the students and let them read each of them asking if they agree or disagree with the written statements
- 4. Ask them to answer to the questions on the workshop sheet.



- 5. Let them talk imagining a conversation between a husband and wife who are trying to work out how to share the housework.
- 6. Let them act out another conversation between a couple who want to make a list of good points for husbands and wives.



Workshop



- 1. Do you agree with any of these ideas? Which one do you think are right or wrong?
- 2. How would you feel about these points of view if you were a husband or wife?
- 3. Is it right that all women should stay at home and be mothers, do the cooking etc.? What do you think?
- 4. Would there be any changes if the wife went out to work everyday?
- 5. Why should a wife want her husband to look after children at the weekend?
- 6. Should a husband do the housework? How should a married couple share the work at home?




