

HOLIDAY (GUIDED, CREATIVE TALKING)

Objective: Students have to use words or phrases (with a holiday theme) which they have chosen at random and write a creative story

Materials: Use the words and phrases (to be cut up)

Procedure

Warm up: Ask the students when and where they're going on holiday this year. Ask them to tell the others if they've had any strange, fantastic or bad experiences on holiday.

1. Now tell them that they have to pick one word (or more – depending on class size) from each of the envelopes. They have to tell a creative story about a holiday using all the words that they have chosen.

2. When they have finished they have to pass their story to another student who will correct it. Then when you have done the final corrections, the students should read out their story.
