### Opposites 2

This teaching activity helps to increase the vocabulary of higher-level students by practicing adjectives and their opposites.

Before class, make one copy of the worksheet for each student.

#### Procedure

Start the activity by saying each adjective and asking for synonyms or examples of its meaning. Students will need to know the meaning of all the words before they can proceed with the activity.

Divide the class into groups of four and give each student a copy of the worksheet.

Read an adjective at random from the worksheet. The first group to give an appropriate opposite gets a point. For an extra point, ask the group to use the opposite adjective in a sentence. All of the students then write down the adjective on their worksheet

The group with the most points at the end is the winner.

After the game has been completed, ask the students to write ten sentences using two adjectives from the worksheet in each sentence, e.g. The peaceful atmosphere was broken by the sound of a terrible scream.

Next, split the students into pairs. Have the students exchange their sentences with their partner and change the adjectives in the sentences to their opposites, e.g. The noisy atmosphere was broken by the sound of an awesome scream.

Finally, ask the pairs to create a short story using the adjectives from the worksheet.
