Name someone who eats quickly.

Name someone who drives carefully.

Name someone who does their homework well.

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Name Someone Who...

In this engaging group activity, students name people who perform activities in a particular manner.

Before class, make one copy of the worksheet for each group of four and cut as indicated.

Procedure

Divide the class into groups of four.

Give each group a set of cards and ask them to shuffle the cards, and place them face down on the table in a pile.

The first student turns over the top card and asks the student on his/her right to name someone who... For example, 'Name someone who eats quickly'.

The student on the right must try to answer the question by thinking of someone who performs the activity in that particular manner.

If the student can answer the question, he/she keeps the card.

Once the student has answered the question, the other students in the group ask follow-up questions to get more information.

If the student cannot answer the question, the card is placed at the bottom of the pile, and the next student takes a card and so on.

The students continue until all the cards have been taken.

The student with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.

Finally, have a class feedback session and elicit the most interesting answers from the students.
