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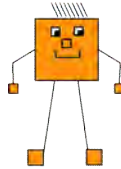
Size, Shape and Colour

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Size, Shape and Colour

In this engaging teaching activity, students learn about adjectives of size, shape and colour.

Before class, make one copy of the worksheet for each student.

Procedure

Divide the class into teams of three and distribute the worksheets.

Tell the students that they are going to put adjectives of size, shape and colour into their respective category.

Set a time limit of ten minutes.

Working together in their teams, the students write the adjectives under the appropriate heading. When the time limit has been reached, tell the teams to stop writing.

Explain that the teams will now call out their answers. Tell them that for each correctly placed adjective, they will win one point.

Call out the first adjective from the box (triangular) and ask the first team for their answer. If the category is correct, all the teams with the same answer score a point.

If the team answered correctly, ask them to explain the meaning of the adjective. They could do this by drawing on the board, pointing to something that can be described using that adjective. They could also make a sentence with the adjective that illustrates the meaning of the word.

If the team can do this, they win an extra point. If the team gives an incorrect category or explanation, move onto the next team.

Repeat this process with each team in turn until all the answers and explanations have been given correctly. The team with the most points at the end is the winner.

As an extension, ask the students to create five sentences with the words from the worksheet using the adjective order of size, shape and colour.
