### Sort it out!

In this rewarding ESL activity, students practice writing and ordering sentences containing adverbs of frequency.

Before class, make one copy of the worksheet for each student.

#### Procedure

Divide the class into teams of three and give each student a copy of the worksheet.

Tell the students that they are going to put words into the correct order to make sentences that contain adverbs of frequency.

Students start with the first sentence on their worksheet. They put the words into the correct order to make an appropriate sentence, adding in any necessary punctuation.

The first team to call out the correct sentence wins three points.

Teams that shout out a wrong answer lose one point.

If everybody is stuck, then help them by giving the first two words of the sentence in the right order.

This continues until all 12 sentences have been completed.

When everyone has finished, tell the students to put the sentences into the correct order to form a text about someone's normal week. The first team to do this wins an additional five points.

The team with the highest score at the end wins.

Some sentences have other possible correct orders, which the students may come up with. If they come up with another possible sentence that makes sense, allow them the points.

### **Answer Key**

- 1. During the week, I always get up at seven o'clock and have a cup of coffee.
- 2. I usually leave the house at quarter to eight.
- 3. I am hardly ever late for work. I normally arrive ten minutes early.
- 4. At lunch time, I usually go to the sandwich shop near my work.
- 5. I don't often get back from work until six o'clock.
- 6. In the evening, I usually watch TV, but sometimes I go to the gym.
- 7. I am usually asleep by ten o'clock.
- 8. I never work at the weekend.
- 9. On Saturday, I usually get up around ten o'clock.
