

All About You - Adverbs of Frequency

Students work alone and choose which adverbs they think are true for their partner. Students then take it in turn to tell their partner their answers, e.g. You sometimes sleep before 10pm. The other student tells them if they are right or wrong. If the answer is wrong, the student gives explains why the answer is incorrect.
