#### Student A

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## The Question is...

This pairwork activity is great for reviewing of Wh- questions.

Before class, make one copy of the worksheet for each pair of students and cut as indicated.

#### Procedure

Divide the students into pairs (A and B) and hand out the worksheets.

Tell the students not to show their worksheets to each other.

Student A starts by reading out their first answer.

Student B listens and tries to guess the question which is on Student A's worksheet in brackets.

If Student B guesses incorrectly, they keep trying until they manage to guess the question.

Student B then reads out their first answer and Student A tries to guess the guestion.

The students continue to take turns until all the questions have been guessed.

Alternatively, you can make the activity more competitive by giving out the Student A worksheet first.

Then, Student B races to guess all the questions correctly in the fastest possible time.

Then, you give out the Student B worksheet and Student A races to complete all the questions.

The winner is the fastest student to complete all the questions.
