TEACH-THIS.COM What's the question?

In this teaching activity, students review question forms.

Before class, prepare a list of answers to questions you want to review.

Procedure

Explain to the students that they are going to play a game where they will be given an answer and they have to race to come up with the correct question.

Give the students an example answer, e.g. I normally arrive home at 6 p.m.

Elicit the correct question from the class, i.e. What time do you normally arrive home?

Divide the class into two teams.

Choose one player from each team to come to the front of the class.

Have the two players stand side-by-side.

Next, read an answer to a question and ask the two players 'What's the question?'

The first player to respond with the correct question wins a point for his or her team.

Then, two new players come to the front of the class for a new round, and so on.

The team with the most points at the end is the winner.
